
## **Don't Click That Phish!**



- X Sender email address is at 'naharpost.com, and should be USPS.com.
- X That 'Reply-to' address shouldn't be there, and shouldn't be the hijacked account 'clinicgroup.org'
- X Spelling and usage errors: companys, couldnt, 'you' instead of 'your'.
- X International date format, day first, 15<sup>th</sup> August.
- X When you slide the mouse over the label link, it doesn't go to USPS.com
- **X** 'Print a shipping label', not a pickup notice. Oops.
- X Your parcel is magically in the 'nearest' post office, and not the office for your ZIP code.
- X The USPS doesn't use employee names in automated email. That should say 'USPS', not 'Manager Michael...'
